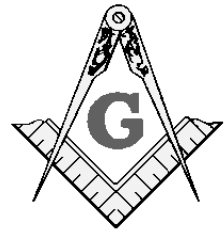

It is with immense and profound sadness that I announce the passing of Most Worshipful Brother Jeremy Jason Sawyer who entered the Celestial Lodge above on Friday, April 18, 2025, at the age of 91.

Most Worshipful Brother Jeremy J. Sawyer served the Grand Lodge of New Hampshire as the 107th Grand Master from 2000 to 2002. He continued his dedication to the New Hampshire Masons by serving the Grand Lodge of New Hampshire as Grand Treasurer from 2002 to 2007. He also was a member of the George Washington Masonic National Memorial, Jurisprudence, DeMolay Foundation, Lodges Bylaws, and New Lodges Committees, as well as a Commissioner on Trials. Brother Sawyer served as Worshipful Master of Saint James Lodge No. 102 of Hampton, New Hampshire in 1978. He was the Grand Representative to Massachusetts and Newfoundland & Labrador, Canada. He served the First Masonic District as District Deputy Grand Lecturer in 1988 and District Deputy Grand Master from 1989 to 1991. He served as Junior Grand Deacon from 1992 to 1994 and as Senior Grand Deacon from 1994 to 1996. He was elected as Junior Grand Warden and served from 1996 to 1997, Senior Grand Warden from 1997 to 1998 and Deputy Grand Master from 1998 to 2000. Brother Sawyer was also a member of the York Rite Bodies, Scottish Rite Bodies, Shrine, and the Order of the Eastern Star.

Calling hours and Masonic Service will be Sunday, May 4, 2025, beginning at 1:00 p.m. at the Remick & Gendron Funeral Home, 811 Lafayette Rd., Hampton.

The funeral will be held Monday, May 5, 2025, at 10:30 a.m. at the 1st Congregational Church, 127 Winnacunnet Rd., Hampton.
